ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY- The races are open to the following classes: **Monohull & Multihull** with LOA over 21' (3 boats are required to make a class) & **Open** (Monohull & Multihull) combined if individual classes are not established in both. There is a \$5 entry fee and NYC membership not required. Entry forms are available on the NYC website at <u>nawiliwiliyc.clubexpress.org</u>. Entries must be received before 0930 on February 3, 2024.

SKIPPER'S MEETING- There will be a skipper's meeting at 0830 hours in the grassy area near the 300 docks entry.

RACE SCHEDULE- The scheduled time of the warning signal for the race start is 0930 hours. Subsequent classes will start at 10-minute intervals.

COURSES- The courses will be selected based on current conditions from combinations of the courses identified as "A", "B", "C", "D", "E", "F", "H", "J", "K", "S", "T", "U", "V", "W", and "X". These course descriptions can be found on the NYC website and at the NYC clubhouse entrance.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS- The Sailing Instructions will be available at the 0830 skipper's meeting and on the NYC website.

SCORING- Scoring will be Low Point using HYRA modifications and NYC 'Club Adjustment' scoring system. There are no throw outs in this race.

PRIZES- Trophies will be awarded at the Annual Awards Ceremony. The number of trophies awarded will depend on the number of boats participating. First place winners of each class will be named on the Opening Day Perpetual Trophy.
