NOTICE OF RACE NAWILIWILI YACHT CLUB WAHINE SERIES JUNE 13, 20, 27 and JULY11, 18, of 2024, 1700

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing and the prescriptions of US Sailing, as modified by NYC.
- 1.2 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, as adapted by NYC, and will be on the NYC website.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the PHRF class, 21 ft LOA and over.
- 2.2 There is a \$25 entry fee and NYC membership not required. Entry forms are available on the NYC website at www.nawiliwiliyachtclub.org/racing. Entries must be received before 1655 on the day of the race. Non-NYC Members will not be recognized as having won a trophy.

3 WAHINE HELMSMAN

This five-race series has the requirement that each boat have a WAHINE (female) at the helm while racing for your score to count normally. If you compete in a race without a lady helmsman, you will be scored DSQ. The person at the helm does not have to be the same female for the entire race or for the entire series. The Race Committee shall be informed as to the name of the female(s) at the helm at the pre-race check-in.

4 DATES: June 13, 20, 27, and July 11, and 18 WARNING TIME: 1700, 1 Race each evening.

5 MEASUREMENT

5.1 Each boat shall produce a valid PHRF certificate, not more than 3 years old.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Standardized Sailing Instructions will be available on N Y C website.

7 VENUE

7.1 Nawiliwili Harbor is the racing area, also shown on course charts.

8 RESTRICTIONS

- 8.1 The Mole and the adjacent area, described by the red "6" channel marker, and sometimes the set red marker, is RESTRICTED.
- 8.2 The area within 300 ft of a moored cruise ship is RESTRICTED.
- 8.3 Boats that enter these areas shall be subject to penalty, including disqualification.

9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed are available as charts on the NYC website.

10 SCORING

- 10.1 Low Point System of Appendix A, with A5.3, will be used.
- 10.2 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 10.3 No race score shall be discarded.

11 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Communication will be on ch. 68. All boats will check in by radio prior to the 5 minute warning signal. Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make additional voice or data transmissions and shall not receive additional voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. Boats that violate this rule may be subject to a penalty, up to and including disqualification.

12 PRIZES

Prizes will be given at annual NYC Awards Event.

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
