## NOTICE OF RACE - NAWILIWILI YACHT CLUB 2022 - WAHINE SERIES

**RULES-** This series of races will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*. U.S. Sailing prescriptions with NYC modifications will apply.

**ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY-** The races are open to the following classes: **Monohull & Multihull** with LOA over 21' (3 boats are required to make a class) and **Open** (Monohull & Multihull) combined if individual classes are not established in both). There is a \$20 entry fee and NYC membership is not required. Entry forms are available on the NYC website at www.nawiliwiliyachtclub.org/racing or at the NYC clubhouse.

This five-race series will have the requirement that each boat have a Wahine (female) at the helm while racing for your score to count normally. If you compete in a race without a female helmsman, you will be scored the number of starters in that race plus 2 points. The person at the helm does not have to be the same female for the entire race or for the entire series. A boat is racing from her preparatory signal until she finishes and clears the finishing line and marks or retires. The Race Committee shall be informed as to the name of the female(s) at the helm at the end of each race.

**RACE SCHEDULE-** Thursdays: June 30, July 7, 14, 21 & 28. The scheduled time of the warning signal for each race start is 1700 hours.

**COURSES-** The courses will be selected based on current conditions from combinations of the courses identified as "A", "B", "C", "D", "E", "K", "S", "T", "U", "V", "W", and "X". These course descriptions can be found on the NYC website and on the NYC clubhouse bulletin board.

**SCORING-** Scoring will be Low Point using HYRA modifications and NYC 'Club Adjustment' scoring system. There will be **NO** throw outs in this series.

**DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY-** Competitors participate in the race entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the race.
