NOTICE OF RACE - NAWILIWILI YACHT CLUB 2024 OFFSHORE SKIPPER'S CHOICE

RULES- This series of races will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). U.S. Sailing prescriptions with NYC modificationswill apply.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY- The races are open to the following classes: Monohull & Multihull with LOA over 21' (3 boats are required to make a class) &Open (Monohull & Multihull) combined if individual classes are not established inboth). There is no entry fee and NYC membership not required.

SKIPPERS MEETING- There will be a skipper's meeting at 0900 hours at the grass area near the 300 series dock to determine:

- the race course of the day
- how the race will start and end (no starter is scheduled)

RACE SCHEDULE- Saturdays: Feb. 24, Mar. 30, Aug. 3, and Oct. 5. The scheduled time of the warning signal for each race start is 1000 hours.

SCORING- Skippers will report their finish times to Rear Commodore, Hu Mast. The scores for these four races will be combined with the scores for the Nawiliwili-Hanalei and back Offshore races to constitute the ten-race (10) Offshore Series. Scoring will be Low Point (Appendix A) using HI-PHRF and NYC 'Club Adjustment' scoring system.
