

# NAWILIWILI YACHT CLUB - SAILING INSTRUCTIONS 2024

## 1 RULES

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-24* and the *Prescriptions of US Sailing*, as modified by NYC.

## 2.0. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

2.1. Notices to competitors will be communicated by Race Committee.

2.2. *Supplementary Sailing Instructions* may be included in the Notice of Race.

## 3. CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1. Any change to the sailing instructions will be communicated by the Race Committee.

## 4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

4.1. Signals made ashore will be displayed from the mole.

## 5. SCHEDULE OF RACES

5.1. The NOR will include the days, dates, number of races scheduled, the scheduled times of the first warning signal each day.

## 6. CLASS FLAGS

6.1. The **PHRF** Class Flag is neon yellow, or as stated in a supplement.

## 7. THE COURSES

7.1. No later than the warning signal, the race committee shall designate the course by displaying letters on the course board.

7.2. The course diagrams are on the N Y C website.

7.3. Course marks are all *rounding marks*.

## 8. THE START

8.1. Races will be started by using RRS [26](#).

8.2. The starting line will be between a staff displaying a Race Committee flag on the MOLE, and the course side of the starting mark.

8.3. The starting mark is a numbered navigational buoy, or an orange set mark, as indicated on the course board.

## 9. THE FINISH

9.1. The finishing line will be between a staff displaying the Race Committee flag on the mole and the course side of the finishing mark.

9.2. The finishing mark is a numbered navigational buoy, or a set orange mark, as indicated on the course board.

## 10. TIME LIMITS

10.1. The time limit is 1845 or 30 minutes after sunset, whichever is earlier.

10.2. Boats failing to finish within the Finishing Window shall be scored Did Not Finish without a hearing. This changes RRS rule 35.

## 12. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

12.1. Protest forms are available from the Race Committee. Protests and requests for redress shall be delivered to the Committee within the appropriate time limit.

12.2. The protest time limit is 2 hours after the last boat has finished the last race of the day.

**12.3.** Notices will be given, no later than 30 minutes after the protest time limit, to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses, and where the hearings will be held.
