

NOTICE OF RACE - NAWILIWILI YACHT CLUB 2022 – INVITATIONAL SERIES

RULES- This series of races will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*. U.S. Sailing prescriptions with NYC modifications will apply.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY- The races are open to the following classes: **Monohull & Multihull** with LOA over 21' (3 boats are required to make a class) and **Open** (Monohull & Multihull) combined if individual classes are not established in both). There is a \$20 entry fee and NYC membership is not required. Entry forms are available on the NYC website at www.nawiliwiliyachtclub.org.

Each boat must have a guest onboard for your score to count normally. If a boat competes in a race without a guest onboard, it will be scored the number of starters in the race plus 1 point (DSQ). Skippers shall report the name of their guest to the race committee ashore following each race.

RACE SCHEDULE- Thursdays: May 26, June 2, 9 & 16. The scheduled time of the warning signal for each race start is 1700 hours.

COURSES- The courses will be selected based on current conditions from combinations of the courses identified as "A", "B", "C", "D", "E", "K", "S", "T", "U", "V", "W", and "X". These course descriptions can be found on the NYC website.

SCORING- Scoring will be Low Point using HI-PHRF and NYC 'Club Adjustment' scoring system. There will be **NO** throw outs in this series.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY- Competitors participate in the race entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the race.
